A Third Language

- Many courses require a third language
- Required for some faculties at UCD, MU, NUIG,UCC
 - eg. Law, Commerce, Arts
- Generally required to study a Language at Third Level
- Exceptions are Science, Engineering and Nursing do <u>not</u> require a language
- NCAD can select ART instead of a language
- A language is <u>not</u> required for TCD, DCU, UL or any Institute of Technology unless a language option within the course
