6 Leaving Certificate subjects 2 H5 4 O6/H7 O6 in English, Irish CAO Points

Some degrees require LC Mathematics e.g. Science and Business

Some degrees require a third language e.g. Arts

Some areas of study require specific subjects



Engineering – Higher Level Maths and a Science or Technology Subject

Science - a Science Subject (in some cases 2 Science subjects)

Mathematics is also a requirement*

*Mathematics permeates Science be aware of the subject content and what will be involved

Do I need a third language?

The NUI's will require a third language in some areas- not all:

MU – 3rd Language required: Arts, Media Studies, Music, Social Science, Psychology (Arts) & BA Community and Youth Work

MU– 3rd Language NOT required: Sciences, Engineering, Product Design, Finance, Business, Accounting, Law, Computer Science, Psychology (Science)

Business Finance/ Accounting



Mathematics is generally required at 04/H7 grade* *Some courses have higher requirement

Be aware of the Mathematical and analytical aspects of these areas of study.
