All transfer applications to the First, Second, Third, Fourth, Fifth Year or Sixth Year Group in St. Mac Dara's Community College will only be accepted after the 01/03/2025 and the closing date for receipt of applications is the 31/05/2025 Applications received after this date will be considered and processed as late applications in accordance with the school's Admission Policy.
